# Steps to Become a Host

## Hosting is Biblical Hospitality in action!

Becoming a Host with Cherished Host Homes happens through a carefully designed process to ensure that you are well prepared for all that hosting involves. You can expect it to take about 1-2 months to work your way through the steps, but it is self-paced, so the timing is completely up to you!

### 1. Initial Phone Screening

The first step is to talk with the Host Home Coordinator. Give us a call at 443-267-4120 or send an email to [info@lovlilife.org](mailto:info@lovlilife.org) to schedule a phone conversation.

### 2. Complete Application Forms

Everyone hates paperwork, luckily, we don't have too much of it! You just need to fill out an Application, Statement of Faith and Background Check Release. We'll run a background check and ask for three references. We will also need a copy of your Driver's License and proof of Homeowner's/Renters Insurance.

### 3. Interview with Host Homes Coordinator

The next step is an interview at your home with our Host Homes Coordinator. We want to get to know you and your family and talk more in depth about the program. This is an opportunity for us to learn about your life and relay the details of the Host Home Experience. We need to get a sense of what your

dynamic is at home so that we'll be able to identify a good fit for you down the road.

#### **4. Trainings and Orientation**

Next, you will work through our training curriculum which focuses on trauma-informed care and biblical hospitality. This includes about 15 hours of in-person training, 10 hours of a Netflix mini-series, and 5 hours of a combination of independent reading, individual meetings with the Host Home Coordinator and our Trainer and creating your Hosting Tools.

#### **5. Home Inspection**

The last onboarding step is the home inspection. This quick check-in helps us to ensure that the space is safe and has the required components, such as a spare bedroom for the Mother, a fire extinguisher in the kitchen, and working smoke detectors. If you're missing something small from our checklist, don't worry, you can fix it prior to a participant moving in.

#### **6. Meet and Greet**

Now that you've completed the onboarding process, we will contact you about meeting with a potential mother! When we have someone on our referral list who we think would be a good fit for you, our Host Home Coordinator will set up a meet and greet. Both parties will be able to ask questions to get to know each other and see if it feels like a match. After the meeting, our Host Home Coordinator will contact you both separately to see what you think. If everyone agrees, the steps towards moving in begin. However, if either side feels uncomfortable, the process will halt. We want your honest feelings and will never move forward if it isn't the right fit for either party.

## 7. Move-In

Our Host Home Coordinator will coordinate with you and the Mother about moving-in, whether transportation needs to be arranged, as well as any items that they are bringing to the house. We're here to help you in any way we can! Thank you for stepping into the life of a Mother choosing life for her Baby, who needs to know Jesus's love in a deeply personal and practical way.
